



How to Obtain NED Roles

Doing Yourself Justice



This session will look at the role of the board and the role of the NED and cover off everything an aspiring NED needs to know.

We will cover the legal perspective and your duties, share the latest governance codes & guidance, and highlight what you really need to know about governance, finance, strategy and risk to sit on a board.

Having covered the roles the session will then look at the opportunities & market intelligence around NED and trustee roles. We will challenge participants to think about their board relevance & transferable skill set and which roles they can apply for.

This workshop is highly practical in its focus and will start looking at how you approach your NED CV and covering letters and include an exercise on applying for a role. Using a live vacancy we will look at what is possible. Attendees will be put into cohort groups to help them stay on track to achieve the success they would like. These will be formed as part of the session.

The workshop is interactive and will cover how non-executives are selected and tips and tricks for finding and applying for roles. We will cover the type of experience and skills that head-hunters and Chairs will be looking for when evaluating applications.

We will conclude with follow up actions and information about taking the next steps to take on an external board role, and how to get the most out of your membership and cohort groups.
